Resolutions which Passed by required Two-Thirds

1. RESOLUTION RE: THE RULE OF LAW & IMMIGRATION

WHEREAS, in a democratic Republic, citizens are to abide by the rule of law for a peaceful and orderly society, and

WHEREAS, the enforcement of immigration law is crucial for upholding the rule of law and ensuring the safety and security of our communities, and

WHEREAS, an individual or divisions within government who disagree with a law, must work within the democratic process to change it, to maintain the rule of law; simply declaring that the division of government will not enforce the law in question is unlawful.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

All levels of Colorado government will rescind any sanctuary City and state laws regarding non-cooperation with immigration officials with respect to illegal immigration.

2. RESOLUTION RE: IMMIGRATION & DEPORTING MIGRANTS

WHEREAS, the United States must have secure geographic borders, and

WHEREAS, since January 20, 2021, the US government has allowed 10+ million migrants to enter the country illegally, overwhelming Colorado's available housing, public schools, health care facilities, city and state budgets, and threatening the safety of law-abiding citizens.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

Any Colorado law enforcement officer shall arrest and deliver to US Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE for deportation any non-citizen who entered the country illegally.

3. RESOLUTION RE: CRIMINAL LENIENCY

WHEREAS, Fentanyl deaths, car thefts, shoplifting and looting are now considered misdemeanor crimes, and

WHEREAS, these types of criminal activities have killed civilians and police officers in the line of duty, while the perpetrators are often free within hours of their arrests.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That these criminal actions, and others, be dealt with as serious crimes that have major consequences such as time in prison.

5. RESOLUTION RE: ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, elections belong to The People, and

WHEREAS, mailing ballots to voters, in a mail-in ballot system allows fraudulent ballots from unidentified voters to enter the system and be counted, diluting the vote of every eligible voter, and

WHEREAS, all electronic computer tabulation systems can be hacked and vote counts changed, making election results untrustworthy, and

WHEREAS, this requires every voter to show a valid picture ID and not allow the vote tally for an election to be audited by citizens, allows for fraud.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

The Republican Party of Colorado shall work to change the law as follows:

1. Voting shall be in person, by US citizens only, in the voter's precinct, with a legal government issued photo ID, and shall occur on Election Day, which shall be made a Holiday
2. Election judges shall count the ballots in person, in the precinct, by hand tally, and be live streamed
3. There shall be no ballot drop boxes and no electronic computer equipment used to count or process votes
4. Eligible voters unable to vote in person may be allowed to vote by mail contingent upon valid identification being included
5. Citizen audits shall be allowed.

6. RESOLUTION RE: BASIC EDUCATION FOR YOUTH

WHEREAS, the success and continued future of our nation depends on rearing children with the best possible education, and

WHEREAS, almost without exception, no school district in CO is graduating a high percentage of children with good to excellent test scores or a firm grasp of basic traditional liberal arts education, and

WHEREAS, the recent introduction of non-basic "diversity type programs" (i.e., CRT, DEI, gender identity, systematic racism, etc.) significantly reduces a child's learning time for basic traditional liberal arts education.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

Pre-K – 12 education must focus only on providing basic traditional liberal arts education (in math, reading, writing, science, history, civics, the arts, and sports) and not include non-basic “programs,” which take time-away from such basic education.

7. RESOLUTION RE: VOUCHERS FOR EDUCATION

WHEREAS, to ensure that each child has the opportunity for the best and most effective possible education, and

WHEREAS, every parent has the right and the primary responsibility to provide the best and most effective type of education for their own children.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

Payment vouchers equal to the public school total per-student cost for each child should be given annually to each family for use in paying for all or part of any form of Pre-K–12 education chosen by the family. The ability for parents to select schools for their children using a voucher system helps the United States stay competitive and strong.

8. RESOLUTION: RE: COMPETITIVE SPORTS BETWEEN MALES & FEMALES

WHEREAS, in the natural order of human existence there are only two biological sexes, which are identified by chromosomes XY and XX, and respectively define males and females, and

WHEREAS, each set of chromosomes creates their own distinctly different physiological characteristics in areas such as strength, speed, and flexibility, which are necessary for competition in sports.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

To give boys and girls a “level playing field” with fair and safe competition in all sports, at-birth biological boys shall only compete against other at-birth biological boys, and at-birth biological girls shall only compete against other at-birth biological girls.

9. RESOLUTION RE: SEPARATE BATHROOMS

WHEREAS, in the natural order of human existence there are only two at birth biological sexes, which are identified by chromosomes XY and XX, and respectively define males and females, and

WHEREAS, when using public restroom, showering and undressing facilities, biological differences are distinctly different.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That all such public facilities (including schools) shall have separate rooms for such usage, one for at birth-biological males and one for at-birth biological females.

10. RESOLUTION RE: SEX CHANGE IN CHILDREN

WHEREAS, in the natural order of human existence there are only two biological sexes, which are identified by chromosomes XY and XX, and respectively define males and females, and

WHEREAS, the biological sex is not arbitrarily assigned by any person at the time of birth, and

WHEREAS, medical “advice” that promotes intervention with puberty blockers, opposite sex hormones and amputation of genitalia/breasts can be reversed without physical or psychological harm are untrue.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Republican Party of Colorado shall work to outlaw any such surgeries and/or chemical/drug treatment for children, and instead, shall encourage healthy therapies to assist those with gender dysphoria.

11. RESOLUTION RE: 2ND AMENDMENT RIGHTS

WHEREAS, HB 23-1219 requires a three-day waiting period before a lawful gun purchaser is allowed to take possession of a lawfully purchased firearm, and

WHEREAS, HB 23-1219 clearly violates the 2nd Amendment to the United States Constitution.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Republican Party work for repeal of HB 23-1219

12. RESOLUTION RE: OPPOSITION TO SB24-084 COLORADO DISINFORMATION ACT

WHEREAS, The freedom of speech is a foundational principal of our democratic republic, enshrined in the 1st Amendment to the Constitution of the United States, and

WHEREAS, SB 24-084, requires the Attorney General of the State of Colorado to undertake certain actions in an effort to prevent the proliferation of misinformation and disinformation, and

WHEREAS, The Colorado Disinformation bill introduces measures that while alleged to combat misinformation and disinformation, pose a significant risk to the free exchange of ideas, potentially stifling public discourse and infringing upon individual rights to free speech.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Republican Party strongly oppose any Disinformation Act, as it establishes overreaching government control.

That the Republican Party commit to promote policies that prioritize the protection of free speech, right of privacy and preservation of a free, open, and secure internet as pillars of a vibrant, democratic society.

That copies of this resolution be disseminated to members of the Colorado General Assembly, the office of the Attorney General, made available to the public through media channels and the Republican Party website to express our firm stance on this critical issue and encourage broader community engagement and advocacy.

13. RESOLUTION RE: INSIDER TRADING

WHEREAS, Members of Congress and the Senate are often privy to “inside” confidential information for a corporation that trades on a stock exchange, and

WHEREAS, Lawmakers often draft and pass laws and regulations that will have a positive or negative effect on a company’s stock, giving lawmakers a unique financial advantage.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That representatives of Congress and the Senate, including family members, shall not be allowed to trade in the stock market during their terms in office.

15. RESOLUTION RE: CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO OPEN CARRY OF FIREARMS

WHEREAS, 28 States in the United States currently have a constitutional right to open carry firearms in their state Constitutions, and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Constitution contains no such provision, and

WHEREAS, Self-defense and the right to defend one's family, property and other innocent persons is a natural right that pre dates the formation of the nation, and

WHEREAS, the type of weapons a person may possess to defend one's family, property or other innocent persons has changed over time.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Colorado Constitution be amended to provide for the right to open carry firearms.

That the Republican Party will uphold the right of the people under the 2nd Amendment to the United States Constitution that the people have the right to keep and bear arms commensurate with common weaponry in use in common practice by its citizens.

16. RESOLUTION RE: SUPPORT FOR SMALL AND MEDIUM SIZED BUSINESSES

WHEREAS, Small businesses are essential to the sustainable growth of our cities and state.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Republican Party support removal of restrictive regulations and laws that hinder small and medium sized businesses from being established and allowed to grow.

17. RESOLUTION RE: REPEAL OF BALLOT INITIATIVE RE-INTRODUCING WOLVES INTO COLORADO

WHEREAS, Wolves are a danger to Colorado live stock, and

WHEREAS, The reintroduction of wolves into Colorado has caused hardship to the livestock industry which is not fully resolved by compensation from the state to those who have lost livestock as a result of killing by wolves.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Colorado Republican party support repeal of the ballot measure allowing reintroduction of wolves into the state of Colorado.

18. RESOLUTION RE: BAN GOVERNMENT LOCKDOWNS

WHEREAS, Without constitutional authority, city and state government ordered lockdowns of certain but not all public and private places, and

WHEREAS, The lockdowns have been shown to be detrimental to the citizens of the cities and state of Colorado, and

WHEREAS, lockdowns have been shown to cause more harm than good to the people affected by them.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Republican Party support a ban in cities and the state of Colorado of lockdowns of any public or private functions as they are unconstitutional.

19. RESOLUTION RE: ASSISTED SUICIDE

WHEREAS, Medicine is designed to assist the sick in the process of healing, and

WHEREAS, Providing the means for an individual to end their natural life is a violation of medical ethics.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the Republican Party of Colorado work:

1. To prevent the enactment of any law promoting active euthanasia.
2. To repeal laws allowing for physician assisted suicide.
3. Support all efforts to provide compassionate palliative care.
